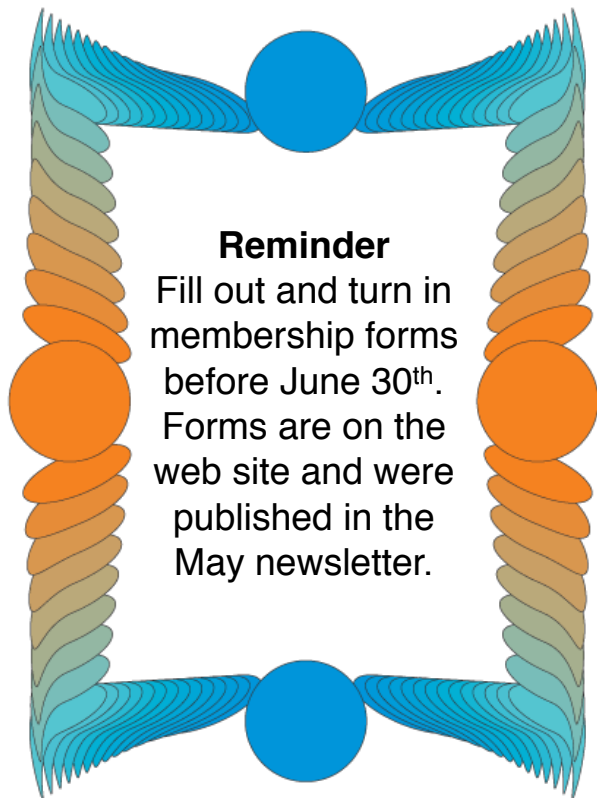

*Widder Quilt:* Peggy reported that almost \$1000 was raised for the raffle. Congratulations to winner Sue Druschke.

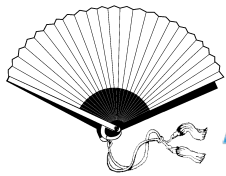
*Next Meeting:* June 9, 2016

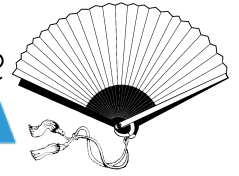

## *Show Committee Meeting Notes and Information*

Dates for the 2017 Quilt show are April 8 & 9, 2017 at the Expo Center.

April 6, Thursday: Members are to bring their quilts to the Expo center and members then will start assembling items, mark off with tape where vendors, quilts, etc. will be located. Turn the Heat ON.

April 7, Friday: Set up day to hang the quilts, etc.

Show Times: Saturday 9 A.M. – 5 P.M. ☐ Sunday 9 A.M. – 3 P.M.

Newsletter info from Peggy Valitchka: Get any newsletter material to Peg the day after the committee meeting for inclusion in the newsletter published the Saturday prior to the normal guild meeting.

If members can give Fran/Peggy the information earlier that is ok as Fran has a file he keeps items in and pulls out the information for the appropriate date of the newsletter.

Challenge quilt name has changed to Quilt Trail Challenge of Manitowoc County. These do not need to be quilts.

It was asked if any committee needs more assistance? No one needs any at this time.

Jar of mix dry ingredients goes well (as cookie ingredients) for use in the charity booth.

Anyone helping with set up of the quilt show ask the husbands to bring drills, extension cords, tool cases, step ladders etc.

It was suggested to put in the newsletter for members when doing their spring cleaning to donate sharp knives, serving trays, utensils to the guild to keep in the POLQ shed for the quilt show or other needs. Utensils, trays, knives are not provided at the expo center.

Reminder to all members: When registering table runners, etc., please note on registration form if it is to be hung up as Landscape or Portrait.

Discussion on a youth wanting to enter their quilt in the adult sections. Is this possible? Yes, one can do this, but once this is done, any show quilts registered thereafter by this youth will be entered in the adult quilt sections.
