## FALL CAMP QUILT REGISTRATION FORM

**DATE:** Friday, Saturday, Sunday – September 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> & October 1<sup>st</sup> 2017

**LOCATION:** Camp Tapawingo, 915 W Tapawingo Rd., Mishicot, WI

Tapawingo Rd is located 3 miles north of intersection Hwy 147 and county trunk B.

Take Cty B to Tapawingo Rd, turn west onto Tapawingo and travel about 1 mile to the camp on the left.

**DETAILS:** Start with 8A.M. breakfast at Two Rivers Restaurant in Two Rivers, corner of Hwy. 147 & Tannery Road; then proceed to camp and set up. Friday lunch on your own. Friday supper is pot luck with no use of the kitchen facilities. Please use crock pots or Nescos. We will use disposables Friday. Please sign up for a dish to pass, snacks or disposables. Saturday and Sunday meals will be made by the camp committee and other campers will be responsible for dishes and clean up. This allows us to keep costs to a minimum.

**FEES:** \$55 per member and \$75 for non-member. Please send a check made out to POLQ and a completed registration form to Kay Rusch, 9719 Sunrise Lane, Two Rivers, WI 54241, by Sept. 13, 2017. ***NOTE:** Registration is open to members ONLY through Sept. 14<sup>th</sup>. Registration will open for non-members on Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>. Only 30 registrations will be accepted.*

**DOOR PRIZES:** No allotment is made for this. As we have done in the past; anyone wishing to participate should bring a wrapped prize (about \$10) and their name will be put in the prize drawing.

## One Block Wonder Workshop

A one day workshop to learn the technique for "One Block Wonder." These quilts are truly one of a kind and can be such original works of art, without much work! If you have always thought you could never create an original art quilt, but wished it were so, then this class is for you!!!

## One Block Wonder Supply List:

Measure the pattern repeat on the fabric you choose. A 24" repeat will require 4 yds. plus an extra yard for border. All fabrics require a minimum of 6 repeats plus an extra yard. Choose a large print fabric with about 5 colors.

You might want a coordinating border fabric, but you can wait to decide that.

- Sewing machine
- Thread to match fabric.
- Flannel backed table cloth for design wall and to take home with you.
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- 60 degree ruler or a 24" ruler with a 60 degree line on it. You will also need a 24" long ruler to cut your strips with – They could be the same ruler, if it has the 60 degree line.
- Straight pins
- Basic sewing supplies.
