You've seen her on two segments of HGTV's *Simply Quilts*, several segments of *Kaye Wood's Quilting Friends and Quilter's Toolbox* on PBS and on *The Quilt Show* with Ricky Tims and Alex Anderson.

Beth has twice been nominated for The Professional Quilter's Teacher of the Year Award.

Minutes of the June 9th, 2016 Meeting

This summer is a great time to finish projects and select from finished quilts by applying a hanging sleeve and label.

We also need quilts for quilt walk displays in the county. Sign up for your place of display and report to Mary Kempf or Julie Puestow.

The Challenge for the quilt show is entitled "Quilt Trail Challenge of Manitowoc County". Using fabrics of their choice, members are encouraged to create a "quilty" item or quilt using inspiration from Manitowoc County. Members may be influenced by history, landmarks, festivals, industry, colleges, traditional pieced quilt patterns, agricultural, etc. There are no size or fabric requirements. The Challenge has only one rule: The item must have a theme related to Manitowoc County. Quilt show chairman still need members to prepare and plan the Friday food.

DATE: Friday, Saturday, Sunday – September 30th, October 1st & 2nd, 2016

LOCATION: Camp Tapawingo, 915 W Tapawingo Rd., Mishicot, WI

Tapawingo Rd is located 3 miles north of intersection Hwy 147 and county trunk B.

Take Cty B to Tapawingo Rd, turn west onto Tapawingo and travel about 1 mile to the camp on the left.

DETAILS: Start with 8A.M. breakfast at M & M diner in Two Rivers; then proceed to camp and set up.

Friday lunch on your own. Friday supper is pot luck with no use of the kitchen facilities. Please use crock pots or Nescos. We will use disposables Friday. Please sign up for a dish to pass, snacks or disposables. Saturday and Sunday meals will be made by the camp committee and other campers will be responsible for dishes and clean up. This allows us to keep costs to a minimum.

FEES: \$55 per member and \$75 for non-member. August 4th Quilt Show Meeting Notes

Appraiser/Judging: Committee members have contacted Carol Butzke to appraise and judge. Appraiser is scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, April 8, 9, 2017. Judging will be done Thursday P.M., April 6, 2017. Appraiser cost is \$50.00.

There was a discussion on the cost of judging/appraisal. It was mentioned that the tax mileage one is able to use for mile expense is 54 cents. The committee is going to verify the cost of Carol's duties. Price per day, mileage, etc.

Baskets/Charity Booth: They would like anyone to donate baskets, groups of members can go together on this.

Towels will also be for sale in these area. Towels, as applique, dish and hand towels, seasonal towels, towels that have a crochet top to place on stove handles, etc.

Publicity: Co-chairs to ask this committee if appraisal and judging are mentioned on the show flyer/ads? (Just to make sure this is on the flyers.)

Quilt Layout: Will await to start receiving quilt registrations.

Quilt Registration: Discussed changing part of the form, and changes approved by show committee members. March 9, 2017 will be hard deadline to register and the guild members will be informed of this at the picnic, August 11, 2016. An incentive will be offered to those who start registering as early as September 2016. The \$150 needed for this committee was approved. These monies will come out of the miscellaneous part of the budget.

Raffle Quilt/Raffle Tickets: Joan is taking care of the raffle tickets and license and the license for the basket raffle.

Vendors: Kay Olker – Contracts have been sent out to the vendors. Some have returned contracts to Kay.

Work Schedule: Ellie and Connie are doing the Friday food and will need 2-3 members each to assist with Friday A.M. and P.M.

Friday Food: Ellie and other show committee members suggested the above for Friday food helpers.

Quilt Show Food, Saturday and Sunday: Winnie did check with county/state regulations on us having the bake sale. This is all right providing the baked goods are not refrigerated. Also discussed that this group could cook the main food at Grace Congregational Church in Two Rivers, for a fee; a lower fee if one of our guild members are members of that church.

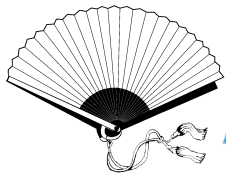

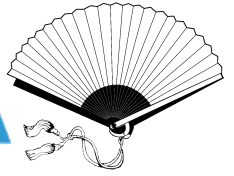

IMPORTANT: the registration deadline is March 9, 2017. We will **NOT** accept any quilts after that date. To encourage you to submit your quilts early, we will be having a drawing each month for a \$25 gift certificate. If you submit a quilt registration, either by email, mail, or in person at a meeting, you will be entered into the monthly drawing once for each quilt you register. Your name will stay in the pot until the drawings are over or you win. You do not need to be present to win. We will have a drawing each month from September through February. **Important** – get your quilts registered early so you will be eligible for more drawings!!!

Simply register your quilt and either mail, email, or bring the registration form for each quilt to a meeting. We will add the names for each quilt we receive a registration form for to the drawing. It is ok (and encouraged) to fill out a form for an unfinished quilt which you will be entering and hand it in before it is finished.
